CCWP Program's Continuing Education and Recertification Process

Congratulations on earning the Certified Contingent Workforce Professional (CCWP) credential. This industry certification validates your knowledge and expertise in the rapidly changing world of contingent workforce program management. Now it's time for you to maintain your credential through ongoing participation in professional education events and knowledge training investments.

The purpose of CCWP Continuing Education (CE) is to encourage certified individuals to stay current of the evolving knowledge and skills in contingent workforce program management, and promote the ongoing competency of those certified.

CCWP Certification is initially valid for three years. In order to maintain your CCWP Certification, a total of 24 Continuing Education Units (CEUs) must be earned during this three year certification time frame. We recommend a goal of 8 units per year. By attaining your Continuing Education Unit goals within the three-year recertification period, you do not need to re-take the CCWP certification class and exam. Each recertification applicant, upon completion of the CCWP Continuing Education process will be charged a small administrative fee to complete and register their recertification. Another three-year CCWP certification term is granted to each recertification applicant completing their CCWP Continuing Education program requirements. Proof of completion or attendance at each CEU event will be required. To obtain your CCWP CEUs, follow these steps:

- 1. Register for and complete the event attendance and participation requirements
- 2. Fill out the Staffing Industry Analysts' online CEU submittal form
- 3. Upon submission you will receive confirmation that Staffing Industry Analysts has received your CEU submittal form.

 Once your units have been verified, you will receive an email from Enterprise Services.

Expired Certification Status

The CCWP Continuing Education program must be completed in order to maintain your CCWP certified status. In the case that CCWP Continuing Education is not completed, your CCWP certification status will be considered expired and you'll need to get recertified. When a CCWP Certification expires, you must retake the current class and pass the current certification exam again. You may take the class in any form you choose: online, Staffing Industry Analysts in-person class event or through a CCWP Partner class.
